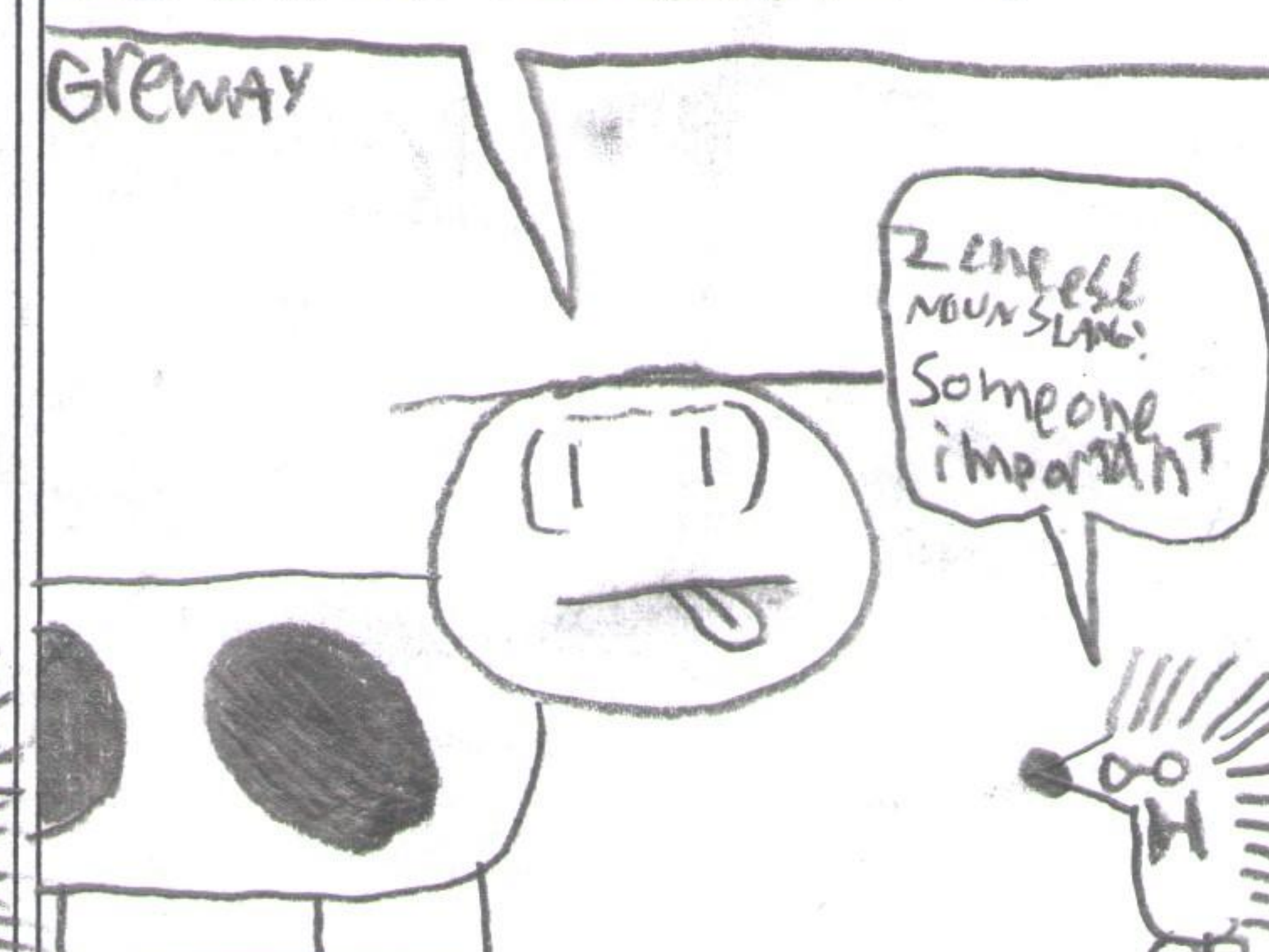
NOUN, OFTEN ATTRIBUTIVE

separated from the whey

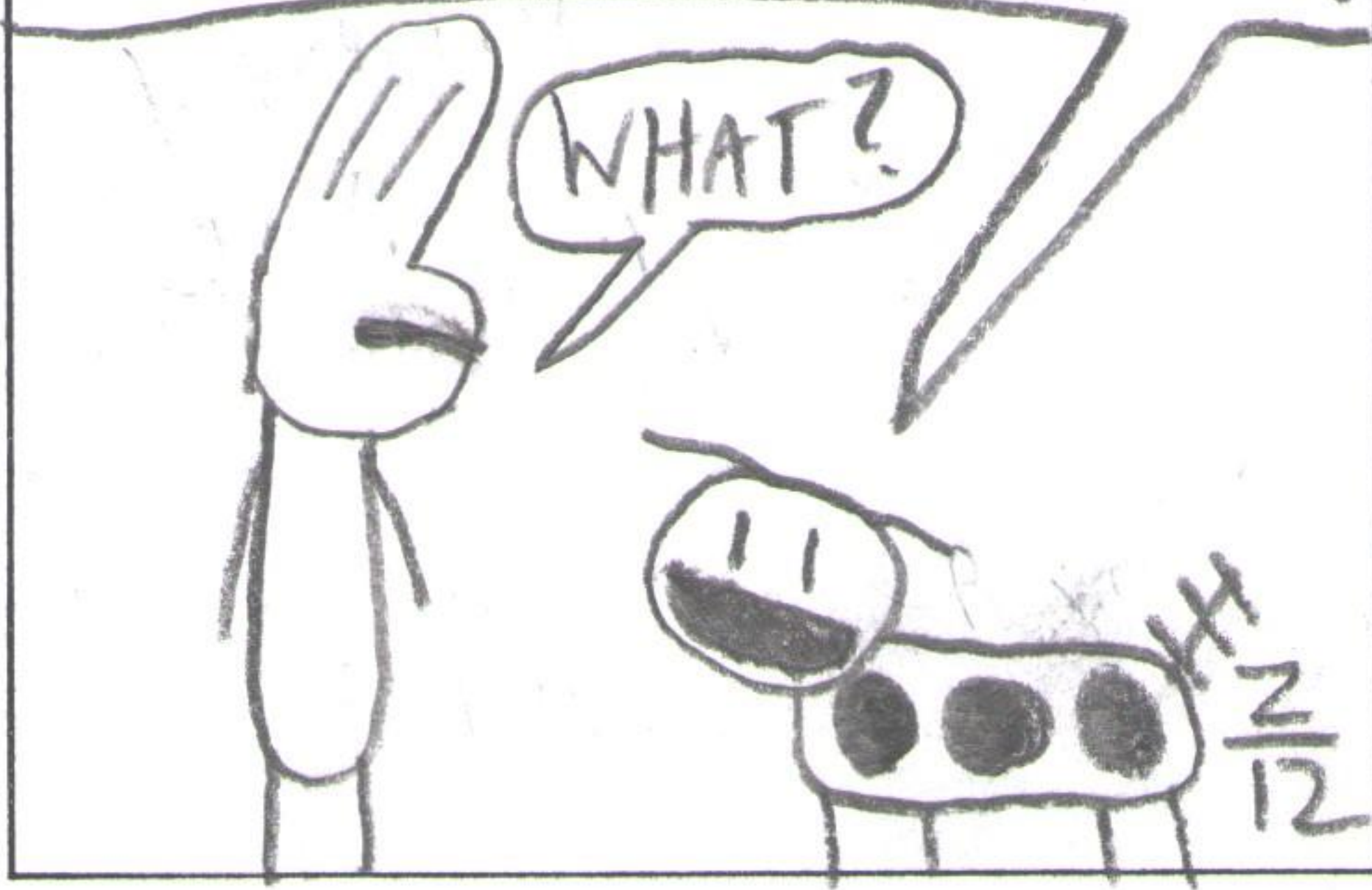
